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Specific Part

1 Technical description of the product

The Mungo heavy-duty anchor MSB (type MSB/MSB-A4, type MSB-S/MSB-SA4, type MSB-P) in the range of M6, M8, M10 and M12 is an anchor made of galvanised steel or stainless steel which is placed into a drilled hole and anchored by torque-controlled expansion.

The product description is given in Annex A.

2 Specification of the intended use in accordance with the applicable European assessment Document

The performances given in Section 3 are only valid if the anchor is used in compliance with the specifications and conditions given in Annex B.

The verifications and assessment methods on which this European Technical Assessment is based lead to the assumption of a working life of the anchor of at least 50 years. The indications given on the working life cannot be interpreted as a guarantee given by the producer, but are to be regarded only as a means for choosing the right products in relation to the expected economically reasonable working life of the works.

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






Type MSB (-A4) 1) and Type MSB-S (A4) 2)



Specifications of intended use

Anchorages subject to:

Static and quasi-static loads.

Base materials:

- Reinforced or unreinforced normal weight concrete according to EN 206-1:2000.
- Strength classes C20/25 to C50/60 according to EN 206-1:2000.
- Non-cracked concrete.

Use conditions (Environmental conditions):

- Structures subject to dry internal conditions (zinc coated steel or stainless steel).
- Structures subject to external atmospheric exposure (including industrial and marine environment) and to permanently damp internal condition, if no particular aggressive conditions exist (stainless steel).

Note: Particular aggressive conditions are e.g. permanent, alternating immersion in seawater or the splash zone of seawater, chloride atmosphere of indoor swimming pools or atmosphere with extreme chemical pollution (e.g. in desulphurization plants or road tunnels where de-icing materials are used).

Design:

- Verifiable calculation notes and drawings are prepared taking account of the loads to be anchored.
 The position of the anchor is indicated on the design drawings (e. g. position of the anchor relative to reinforcement or to supports, etc.).
- Anchorages are designed under the responsibility of an engineer experienced in anchorages and concrete work.
- Anchorages are designed in accordance with ETAG 001, Annex C, design method A Edition August 2010.

Installation:

- · Hole drilling by hammer drilling only.
- Anchor installation carried out by appropriately qualified personnel and under the supervision of the person responsible for technical matters of the site.
- hexagonal head bolt and washer for type MSB / MSB-A4 may be used if the following requirements are fulfilled:
 - material, dimensions and mechanical properties of the metal parts according to the specifications given in Annex A 3 and B 2,
 - confirmation of material and mechanical properties of the metal parts by inspection certificate 3.1 according to EN 10204:2004, the documents should be stored,
 - Length of hexagonal head bolt according to Table B1 shall be complied with.
- in case of aborted hole: new drilling at a minimum distance away of twice the depth of the aborted hole or smaller distance if the aborted drill hole is filled with high strength mortar and if under shear or oblique tension load it is not in the direction of load application.
- anchor installation such that the effective anchorage depth is complied with. This compliance is ensured, if the leading edge of expander does not more exceed the concrete surface.


